There is enough evil in the crying of wind.

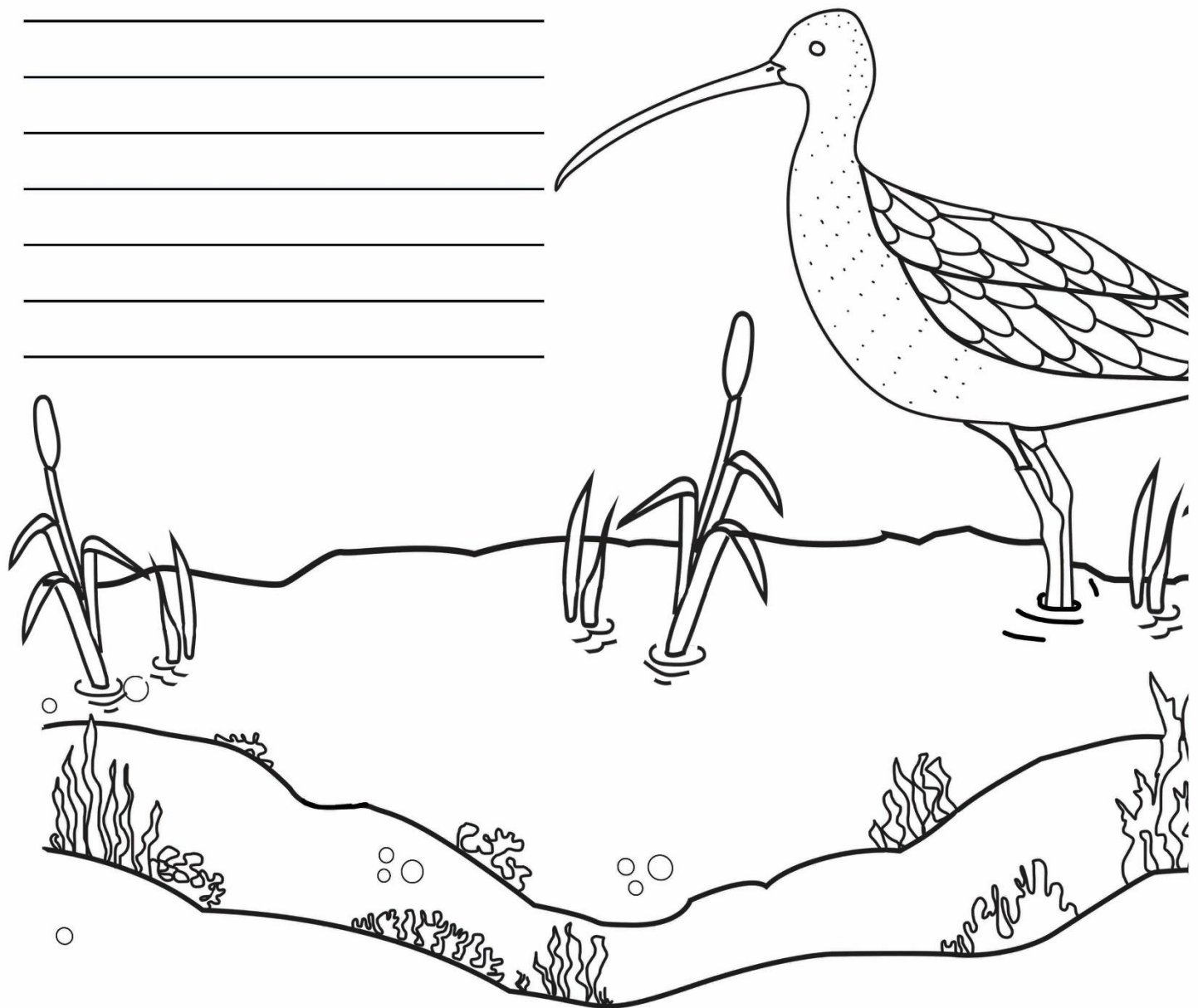
